To be considered, you must:

- 1. Enter SFA as either an incoming freshman or a new transfer student beginning in fall 2016
- 2. Complete the SFA STEM Scholarship application and return it to the dean's office located in the Miller Science Building Room 100, by 5 p.m. April 1, 2016
- 3. Declare a STEM major
- 4. Submit at least one letter of recommendation from a STEM faculty member (college or high school, as appropriate)
- 5. Enroll as either an incoming freshman with a math SAT/ACT of at least 600/26 **OR** as a transfer student with at least a 3.0 GPA in the major and at least a 3.5 GPA cumulatively
- 6. Advance through the interview process with the STEM scholarship committee.

Each scholarship recipient receives \$10,000 per year, up to four years, provided the student maintains the scholarship requirements. The student must make appropriate progress each semester toward the degree requirements for the major.
